Reasoning

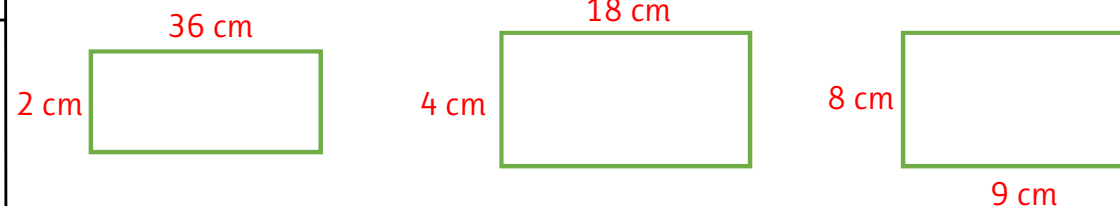
- Jim ate $\frac{70}{100}$ of his pizza. Jane ate $\frac{12}{16}$ of her pizza. Who ate the most pizza?
