

8 RULES TO FORM THE PLURAL NOUNS

1. Add "s" to form plural of most nouns.

EXAMPLE:



star stars

book books

cat cats



2. Add "es" to nouns that end in ch, sh, s, ss, x.

EXAMPLE:



witch witches



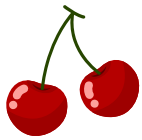
dish dishes

ax axes



3. Nouns that end in consonant with a "y", change "y" to "i" and add "ies".

EXAMPLE:



baby babies

cherry cherries

fairy fairies



4. Nouns that end in vowel with a "y", add "s".

EXAMPLE:



key keys



tray trays

toy toys



5. For nouns that end in "f" or "fe", change the "f" or "fe" with "ves".

EXAMPLE:



leaf leaves

scarf scarves

knife knives



6. For nouns that ends with a consonant before "o", add "es".

EXAMPLE:



tomato tomatoes



flamingo flamingoes

avocado avocados



7. Some nouns change the spelling of singular noun.

EXAMPLE:



mouse mice

tooth teeth

child children



8. Some noun use the same singular and plural form.

EXAMPLE:



fish fish



sheep sheep

moose moose
